Sophomore Boys Basketball--The Sophomore Boys came away from the holiday break with a 2-1 record. We lost a close game to Centennial, 48-42. Trever Bostrom had 13 points and Nate Sherfick added 10. At Meridian, the boys held on to win 49-42. Trever Bostrom led the way again with 18 points and Jake West added 12. At home vs. Timberline the boys pulled out another close win, 46-42. Nate Sherfick led a balanced scoring attack with 10 points. The sophomore Braves hold a 5-5 record halfway through the season with games at home this week against Caldwell and Mt. Sophomore Girls Basketball—The Sophomore Girls lost to Meridian 31-22 on 12/28. Boise had a rough offensive game. Jenna Choate scored 6 pts., Taylor Mello scored 5 pts. and Hattie Werk scored 4 pts. Ayanna Hix had a great defensive game. In the Timberline game on 1/5, Boise won 48-32. Varsity Boys Basketball--After a demoralizing defeat and loss through the mercy rule verses Vallivue, the varsity boys basketball team regrouped and went on a 3 game win streak. Wins were 71 -54 over Kuna, 55 -51 over Centennial, and 85-57 over Meridian. With 3 league wins the braves positioned themselves right in the middle of the league standings. Most recently, the boys withstood a long time off through Christmas break but still managed to have their game together this last Friday night against rival Timberline. Boise managed to take care off the ball and hit enough shots to lead most of the game. However, poor ball handling and turnovers led to easy Timberline baskets. The Braves ended up losing 50 - 65 but new they played well enough to win and the game was actually closer than the score indicated. Coming up the boys play Caldwell on Friday, who just beat league leading Mt. View and then Mt. View on Saturday.
